

POPPY CROCHET PATTERN

Needed: 5 mm crochet hook (or any size close to that), red and black medium weight yarn. Denise D likes the Caron 1b Scarlet. Denise T likes the Red Heart Super Saver. You could use up any red and black acrylic yarn 😊.

Crochet Abbreviations:

ch = chain(s) | dc = double crochet | Sc = single crochet | Sl st = slip stitch | * = repeat cycle

- **Row 1:** With black, Ch3, do not join. Do 11 dc into last chain from the hook. Sl st into top of Ch 3 (counts as a dc). Ch 1 and pull yarn through. **OR Row 1:** With black, Ch4 and sl st into first chain to make a circle. Ch 3 (counts as a dc), dc 11 more stitches into round, sl st into first dc to close the circle. **You should have 12 dc.**
- **Row 2:** Change to red and join to top of any black dc. Ch 3, work 1 dc in same stitch. Work 2 dc into each dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. **You should have 24 dc. Do not turn.**
- **Row 3:** Ch 3, work 1 dc in same stitch. Work 2 dc in each of the next 3 dc (8 dc group) *sc into each of the next 2 dc, 2 dc in each of the next 4 dc*. Repeat from *to* ending with the 2 sc and joining with a sl st into the ch3 at the beginning. (4 sets of 8 dc + 2 sc). Do not turn.
- **Row 4:** Ch 3, work 1 dc in same st. Work 2 dc into each of the next 7 dc (you should have 16 dc), *skip next st, sl st into next st. Work 2 dc in each of the next 8 dc* Repeat from *to* 3 times. To join, single crochet and sl st to top of ch 3. Pull yarn through loop and cut off.
- **You've just completed a poppy!**

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
